MO0089 della Biblioteca Estense Universitaria di Modena, a 4 parti, intitolato *“Dodici Sinfonie a più VV.ni... , con B. C.”*. La Sinfonia di Modena, più breve nel primo movimento e con un secondo movimento in 3/8 completamente diverso, riporta la dicitura: *“Prima Sinf.a Grossa del Concerto delle Viole con le parti del Concertino Repliche”*.

La trascrizione riguarda la fonte di Torino. Ogni aggiunta dell’editore è tra () o [] o con legature tratteggiate.

In copertina si trova copia della prima pagina della partitura del ms Foà-Giordano.

La versione 1.0 è stata pubblicata il 14 novembre 2006. La revisione 1.1 è del 23 gennaio 2007.

EDITORIAL NOTES

The sources are two ms. of the score from Serenata “Il Damone”: ms. TO026518600, Biblioteca Universitaria di Torino - Fondo Foà Giordano. In 7 parts and ms. Mus. MO0089, Biblioteca Estense Universitaria di Modena, with caption title: *“Dodici Sinfonie a più VV.ni... , con B. C.”*. The Modena “Sinfonia” has caption title: *“Prima Sinf.a Grossa del Concerto delle Viole con le parti del Concertino Repliche”*. This second ms. has a shorter first movement and a second completely different movement in 3/8.

The transcription uses Torino ms. as primary source. All additions of the editor are between () or [] or with dashed slurs.

Cover includes a copy of the image included in the first page of the Foà-Giordano score.

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
