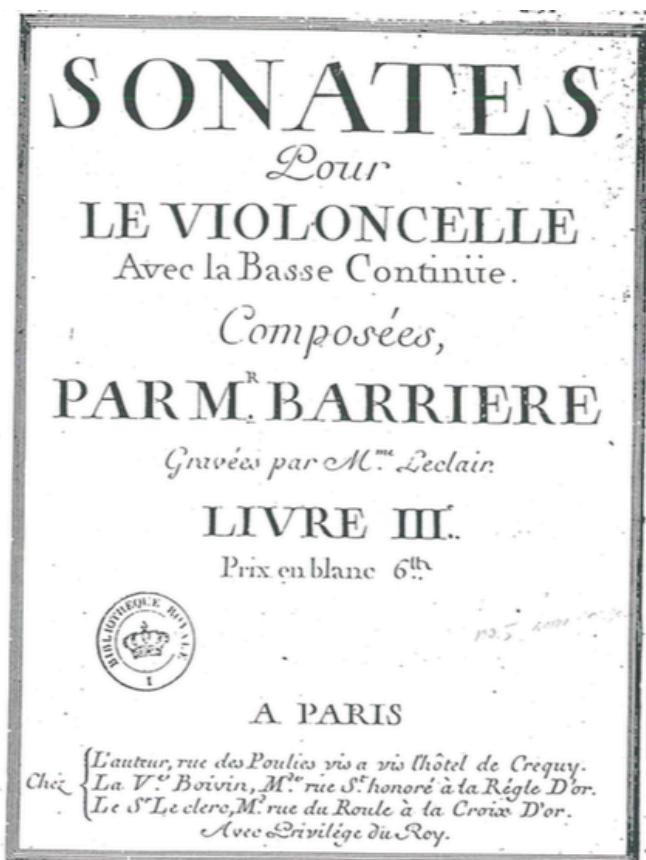

## [2.] Allegro

## NOTE EDITORIALI

La fonte è l'edizione a stampa della partitura della “Sonata II a tre”, inclusa nella raccolta: „*Sonates pour le violoncelle avec la Basse Continüe ... Livre III ... gravées par Mme Leclair*”, 1733 Paris, disponibile presso la Bibliothèque nationale de France, Département de la Musique (F-Pn).

La sonata non riporta indicazioni strumentali. La parte in chiave di violino ha l'estensione del flauto traversiere, mentre la seconda parte in chiave di tenore è probabilmente intesa per il violoncello.

L'edizione antica è corretta. In copertina si trova copia del frontespizio originale.

La versione 1.0 è stata pubblicata il 30 settembre 2017.

## EDITORIAL NOTES

The source of “Sonata II a tre” is the printed edition of the score, included in the collection: “*Sonates pour le violoncelle avec la Basse Continüe ... Livre III ... gravées par Mme Leclair*”, 1733 Paris, available at the Bibliothèque nationale de France, Département de la Musique (F-Pn).

There is no mention of the instrumentation of this trio, but the first part may be played on a flute or on a violin, while the second part may be played on cello.

The ancient edition is almost flawless. In cover there is copy of the frontispiece from the ancient edition.

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
