NOTE EDITORIALI

La fonte di “*Pour un reposoir*” [H.508], I (1673), è il ms. autografo della partitura incluso in *Mélanges autographes: volume I*, Gallica, BNF, Paris. Il manoscritto è corretto con la omissione di qualche accidente.

Nella partitura pubblicata sono state lasciate le chiavi originali, mentre nelle parti separate è stata adottata la notazione moderna. Ogni raro suggerimento dell'editore è indicato con il tratteggio o con parentesi.

In copertina è riportata la copia dell'incipit della partitura autografa.

La versione 1.0 è stata pubblicata il 16 luglio 2017.

EDITORIAL NOTES

The source of “*Pour un reposoir*” [H.508], I (1673), is an autograph ms. of the score, included in *Mélanges autographes: volume I*, Gallica, BNF, Paris. The autograph score is almost flawless except for the rare omission of accidentals.

This is an urtext edition, based on the autograph score. The score was published with the original clefs. The separate parts have the currently used clefs. All editor suggestions are in parentheses or with dashed lines.

The cover page includes the incipit from the autograph score.

The version 1.0 was published on July 16, 2017.
