5. la versione 1.0 è stata completata il giorno 5 settembre 2010.

EDITORIAL NOTES

1. Source of *Symphonies pour un Reposoir* [H515] is an autograph ms. of the score published in the digital library Gallica, BNF (M-A. Charpentier, Mé lange XV);
2. the manuscript is almost error free, with a few omissions of accidentals;
3. The ms. was transcribed as it is, except for the use of modern keys in the separate parts for practical performance. Any rare addition is indicated by dashed lines or included in () or [];
4. in cover page there is a copy of a section of the original ms.;
