3. in copertina è riportata l'etichetta antica del manoscritto;
4. la versione 1.0 è stata completata il giorno 29 novembre 2011.

EDITORIAL NOTES

1. The source of Trio GWV C 15,82 by Carl Heinrich Graun is a ms. of separate parts available online at SLUB, Dresden. The Trio is also attributed to the brother Johann Gottlieb or to Klinkenek (Kleinknecht?);
2. the ms. is quite correct, except for ties, slurs, accidentals and dynamics, which are omitted and incoherent among the various parts. Any rare editor addition is indicated by dashed lines or included in () or [];
3. in cover page there is the ancient label of ms.;
4. version 1.0 was completed on November 29, 2011.
