## Corno da caccia I

### [1.] Allegro

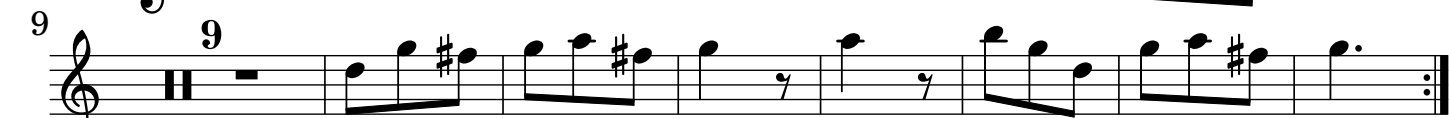

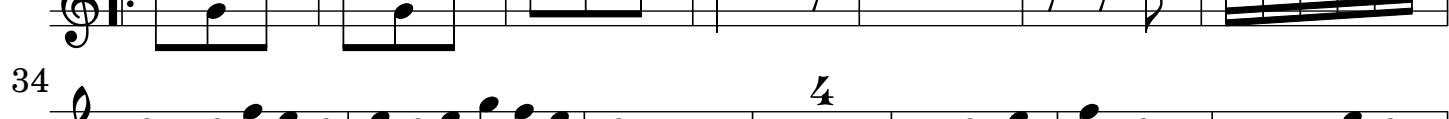
