Il manoscritto è corretto. Ogni intervento del curatore, limitato allo stretto necessario, è tra parentesi o con linee tratteggiate.

EDITORIAL NOTES

The main source is the ms. of the score of the Sinfonia from the opera “*Polidoro*”, opera in five acts by Antonio Lotti, online available at Biblioteca del Conservatorio di musica S. Pietro a Majella, Napoli. A second source is a ms. of parts of an arrangement with horns in place of trumpets and the addition of flutes traversieres, SLUB, Dresden (<http://digital.slub-dresden.de/ppn309365171>).

The ms. is almost flawless. All rare suggestions of the editor are in parentheses or with dashed slurs.

The cover includes a copy of incipit from the score.
