

Sonata in Fa minore [TWV 44:32]

Viola II

G. P. Telemann (1681-1767)

[1.] Adagio

First movement, Adagio, measures 1-12. The key signature is three flats (B-flat, E-flat, A-flat) and the time signature is common time (C). The music is written for Viola II. Measure 1 has a 4-measure rest. The melody is characterized by wide intervals and a slow, spacious feel.

[2.] Allegro

Second movement, Allegro, measures 13-46. The key signature is three flats and the time signature is common time. The music is written for Viola II. Measure 13 has a 6-measure rest. The movement is characterized by rapid sixteenth-note passages and a more active tempo.

[3.] Largo

Third movement, Largo, measures 47-9. The key signature is three flats and the time signature is 3/2. The music is written for Viola II. Measure 47 has a 2-measure rest. The movement is characterized by wide intervals and a slow, spacious feel.
