NOTE EDITORIALI

La fonte del *Dixit Dominus* RV 807 è il manoscritto della partitura, reperibile online presso la biblioteca digitale SLUB, Dresden, Mus.2389-E-6, RISM Id n. 212009545. La prima pagina dal ms. riporta: "*Dixit a 4:0 / Con Strumenti / Del Gig: Baldassar Galuppi, detto Buranello / Fatto per l' Ospedale della Mendicanti. / 1745*", con l'errata attribuzione a Galuppi da parte del copista veneziano Iseppo Baldan. Le parti degli archi in chiave di basso sono state trascritte all'ottava inferiore quando possibile. L'opera è stata attribuita a Vivaldi da Janice Stockigt e Michael Talbot, "*Two More New Vivaldi Finds in Dresden*", in Eighteenth-Century Music (2006), p.35-61.

L'editore ha trascritto scrupolosamente il manoscritto originale, che include molte sviste e le usuali omissioni di accidenti, legature e abbellimenti. Tutti i suggerimenti dell'editore sono indicati tra parentesi o con legature tratteggiate.

La copertina include copia dell'incipit tratta dal manoscritto.

The parts "*Con il Basso*" were transcribed to the lower octave, when possible. The score was attributed to Vivaldi by Janice Stockigt and Michael Talbot, "*Two More New Vivaldi Finds in Dresden*", in Eighteenth-Century Music (2006), p.35-61.

The source includes many mistakes, with the usual omission of slurs, accidentals and ornaments. All editor suggestions are in parentheses or with dashed lines.
